Accommodation Pricing and Key Feature Information

As of the 1st of July 2014, all Australian Aged Care providers are required to publish pricing and service details. Further information can be found on the Australian Government website: www.myagedcare.gov.au.

Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), or a combination of both.

A Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD) is paid as a lump sum amount.

A Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP) accrues daily and is paid monthly.

A combination payment includes both a partial lump sum (RAD) and Daily Accommodation Payments (DAP).

The maximum price that a resident could be charged for our Tobruk Wing is set out below.

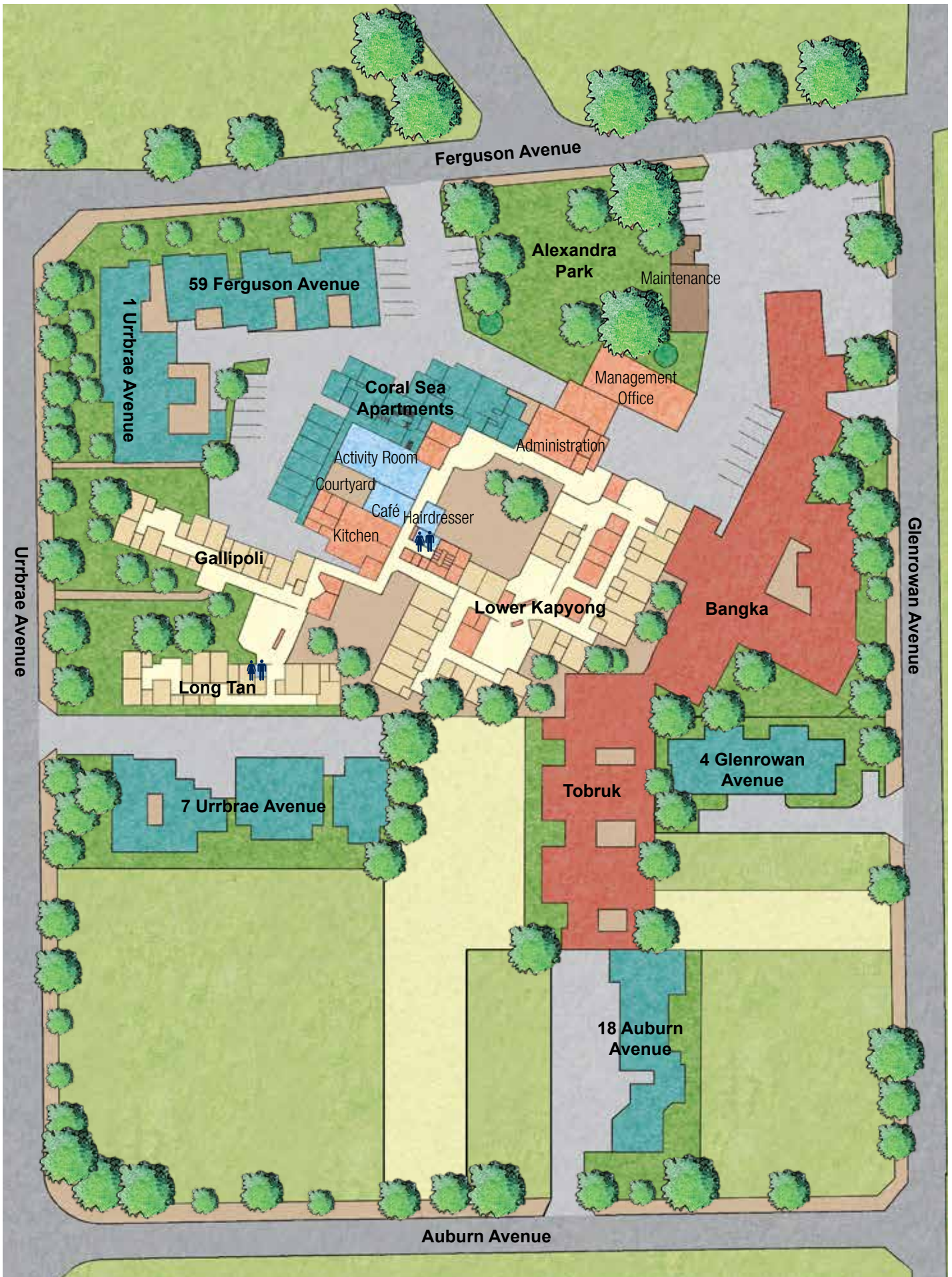

Optional additional services offered at a cost	Hairdressing, telephone calls, dry cleaning, onsite cafe, some excursions and daily newspapers and magazines.

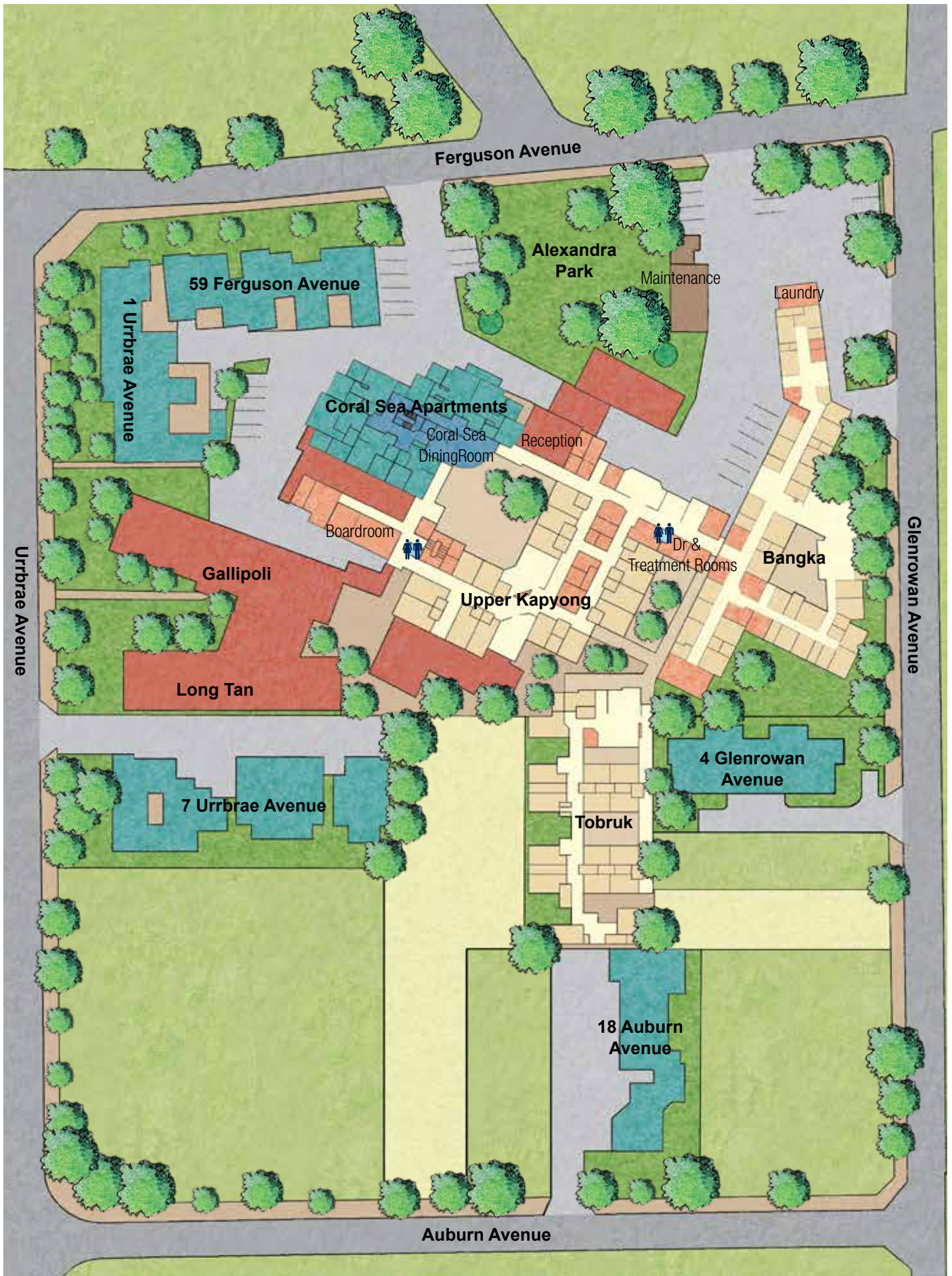




WAR VETERANS' HOME - GROUND FLOOR
